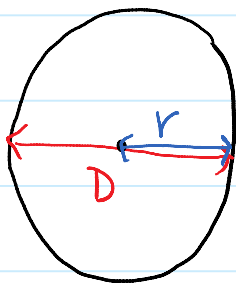


Circumference

- the perimeter of a circle



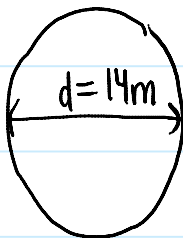
radius
diameter

$$C = 2\pi r$$

or

$$C = \pi d$$

Ex. #1



Find the circumference

$$C = \pi d$$

$$= \pi(14) = 43.96 \text{ m}$$

$$43.98 \text{ m}$$
